It forces a better deal. If gaming passes, revenues must be directed to tribal services for members — not to outsiders, insiders or a Wyoming shell company.

The vote is Tuesday, June 23, 2026

Four days BEFORE Homecoming begins — not during Homecoming

This amendment concentrates power

- 01** One man negotiates all gaming contracts, appoints the gaming board AND the oversight board — confirmed by a council that **just** voted 17-2 in his favor. That is not oversight. That is concentration of power.

Voting NO forces a referendum or a better amendment

- 02** A fair referendum or amendment requires independent oversight, transparent revenue reporting, and a balance of power — not the currently proposed concentration of power in one office.

If gaming passes, revenues must be directed to tribal services

- 03** Revenues must go to tribal services for members — healthcare, education, housing, infrastructure and elder care — not to outsiders, insiders or a Wyoming shell company.
